The University of Bonn is an internationally operating research university. With its research clusters and post graduate programs it is among the top universities in Germany. The Medical Faculty has extensive partnerships with institutions of the Helmholtz Society and the Max Planck Society as well as with national and international collaborative research networks in the life sciences.

The open position is for research, teaching and supervising graduate and post graduate scientists in the area of experimental cell therapy and should strengthen the translational research in this field. Supervising of young graduate and post graduate scientists is highly appreciated. The position includes the responsibility for a GMP-core-facility (200m²) now under construction, which will be completed in 2018.

Applicants (Natural Scientists / Medical Scientists) should have an excellent experience and scientific expertise in cell- and gene-based medicines for the treatment of haematological (including Thrombosis and Haemostasis) and/or oncological diseases. Exemplary areas of interest might be T-cells and/or (induced) pluripotent stem cells.

The position is assigned to the Institute of Experimental Haematology and Transfusion Medicine, University of Bonn (Director: Prof. Dr. med. J. Oldenburg) that hosts the largest center for inherited bleeding disorders in Europe. A close cooperation with the main research and clinical areas of the Medical Faculty is appreciated.

The position calls for tenure track employment for 5 years with an evaluation. After positive evaluation the position will be tenured. Natural scientists are expected to undergo qualifications for manufacturing blood products / cell therapeutics (head of production, head of quality control and qualified person according to the German Medicines Act). Physicians are expected to undergo a qualification to a specialist in Transfusion Medicine that also includes the aforementioned qualifications.

Candidates must comply with the general conditions of employment according to § 36 of the Higher Education Act of North Rhine-Westfalia (Hochschulgesetz des Landes Nordrhein-Westfalen).
